



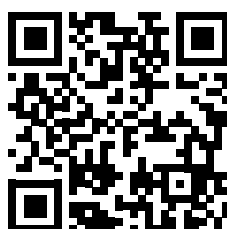

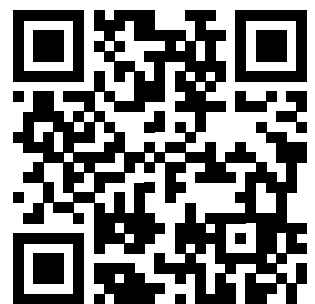
## Experience a new culture
